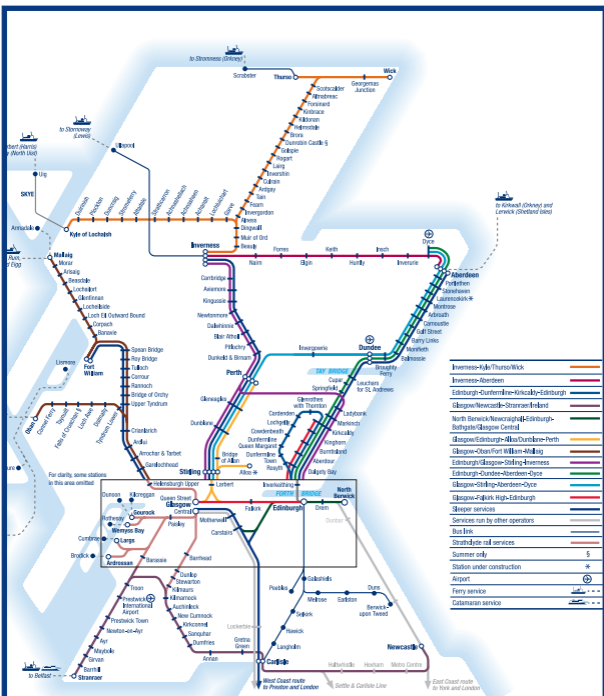

## Welcome to our 2007 Summer Timetable

First ScotRail is delighted to announce a number of enhancements to our services during this timetable period.

The Edinburgh-North Berwick route will have additional evening services on Mondays to Saturdays. Musselburgh will further benefit from extra calls in the morning and evening peak on this route. These improvements will be of particular value to students at the new Queen Margaret University campus.

Ferry connections at Oban to Mull will be improved during the summer months, resulting in a slight alteration to the West Highland Line timetable.

In other improvements the Kyle Line peak summer services will start earlier in the year than previously, boosting tourist opportunities on this scenic route.

Our enhancements are part of our focus on customer service and any alterations are designed to improve reliability and ensure value for money.

Some of our services arriving or departing Edinburgh will continue to be subject to change because of the intensive engineering works in connection with the £150 million upgrade of Edinburgh Waverley station. The project will soon enter a crucial phase in delivering a better rail network for Scotland.

To allow the works to be completed, a number of Fife trains, one Stirling and one Carnoustie service will continue to terminate at Haymarket rather than Waverley. Our customers will be able to transfer to a Waverley service within five to seven minutes.

A small reduction in services from West Calder will also continue, although a substitute bus is provided between West Calder, Livingston South and Kirknewton linking with a train connection to Edinburgh. In addition, most North Berwick to Haymarket services will continue to terminate at Waverley, as will most Newcraighall services.

The Waverley improvements will result in more services, improved punctuality and better access for customers at one of the UK's busiest train stations.
